## Proclamation

## Arizona Aviation Legislative Day

WHEREAS, the Arizona aviation industry is a powerful and reliable source of employment, innovation, tourism and export income to the state and our nation; and

WHEREAS, an efficient and reliable aviation system is a critical element of Arizona's overall transportation system and the vitality of our State's economy; and

WHEREAS, the aviation industry has an estimated \$121.4 billion annual impact on Arizona's economy and plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, Arizona is home to 67 public use airports including 11 commercial service airports, 12 Native American airports, five military airfields and five of the nation's largest flight schools, which account for 575,826 jobs and \$34.2-billion in earnings and 26-million enplaned passengers in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Arizona is also the home to many exceptional sites of air and space activity, including Ft. Huachuca Army Base, Luke Air Force Base, Barry M. Goldwater Air Force Range, the U.S. Army Yuma Proving Ground, Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, and the United States Geological Survey Astrogeology Science Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Arizona is leading in the development and adoption of business services provided by small unmanned aircraft systems, an emerging global market that is valued at more than \$127 billion with a commercial fleet that is expected to grow to over 835,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Arizona has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, education institutions, aviation organizations, community airports: and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Airports Association are sponsoring a day of Legislative meetings to highlight and celebrate the contributions of the aviation community to Arizona.
