

By His Excellency Dannel P. Malloy, Governor: an

Official Statement

WHEREAS, General Aviation and community airports play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operation of our businesses and farms; and

WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut has a significant interest in the continued vitality of General Aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions, aviation organizations, community airports and airport operators; and

WHEREAS, as of December 31, 2013, there were 23 public-use airports in the State serving 5,182 FAA Certificated pilots. In 2012, there were also 2,047 general aviation and on-demand FAR Part 135 aircraft primarily flown in Connecticut; and

WHEREAS, General Aviation plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, many communities in Connecticut depend heavily on General Aviation and community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists and visitors to our State; and

THEREFORE, I, Dannel P. Malloy, Governor of the State of Connecticut, do hereby proclaim the month of September 2014 as
