PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, general aviation and community airports play a critical role in

the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operation of our

businesses and farms; and

WHEREAS, the state of Indiana has a significant interest in the continued

vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation

educational institutions and community airports; and

WHEREAS, many communities in Indiana depend heavily on general

commerce, tourists and visitors to our state; and

WHEREAS, Indiana is home to 117 public-use airports, which, according to
