WHEREAS, aviation and community airports play a critical role in the lives of our

WHEREAS, Louisiana has seven public-use commercial service airports, 63

public-use general aviation airports (which serve 5,475 pilots), 2,807 active general aviation aircraft and is the home to 33 repair stations,

six FAA-approved flight schools and 913 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Development-Office of

Multimodal Commerce estimates that airports contribute more than 6.75 billion to the state's economy each year and many communities depend heavily on general aviation airports for continued flow of

commerce, tourism and visitors; and

WHEREAS, according to the 2015 Louisiana Airports Economic Impact Study,

airports in Louisiana support over 58,800 jobs across the state with

an annual payroll of more than 1.7 billion; and

WHEREAS, aviation plays a vital role in the state's response to emergencies,

natural disasters and rescue operations such as air ambulance transports by fixed-wing and rotorcraft, and also to police, game wardens and mail service that routinely utilize aviation to support

daily operations and communication; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of

aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions,

aviation organizations, community airports and airport operators.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bel Edwards, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do

hereby proclaim October 2018 as

AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH
