

Proclamation

From the Governor of the State of Maryland

GENERAL AVIATION AND COMMUNITY AIRPORT MONTH SEPTEMBER 2017

WHEREAS, General Aviation and community airports play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, businesses and farms; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions and aviation organizations and community airports and airport operators; and

WHEREAS, A recent Maryland Economic Impact of Airports study found that general aviation airports in Maryland supports more

than \$865 million in business-generated revenue; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has 35 public-use general aviation airports, serving 7,677 pilots and 2,284 active general

aviation aircraft. General aviation airports support 6,317 jobs across the state; and

WHEREAS, General aviation plays a vital role in the state's response to emergencies and natural disasters. Rescue operations such as

air ambulance transports by fixed wing and rotor craft, in addition to police, warden, and mail service routinely utilize

general aviation to support daily operations and communication; and

WHEREAS, The nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in

place to ensure stable funding of this system; and

WHEREAS, Maryland is home to 24 repair stations, 13 FAA-approved flight schools and 1,361 flight instructors and 2,005 student

pilots.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LAWRENCE J. HOGAN, JR., GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim SEPTEMBER 2017 as GENERAL AVIATION AND COMMUNITY AIRPORT MONTH in Maryland, and do commend this observance to all of our citizens.
