Proclamation

WHEREAS, New Jersey's General Aviation industry provides direct employment for approximately 18,000 New Jersey residents; and

WHEREAS, General Aviation includes all civilian flying except scheduled passenger airlines; and

WHEREAS, General Aviation plays an important role in the success of many New Jersey businesses and farms and improves the lives of our residents by providing disaster relief and a wide array of travel options; and

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Aviation Association (NJAA) was formed in 2000 to promote, protect and preserve our state's General Aviation industry; and

WHEREAS, NJAA's membership includes a cross section of professionals that represent all corners of New Jersey's aviation interests, with emphasis on the special needs of the state's business community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, do hereby proclaim
