WHEREAS, tens of thousands of general aviation aircraft — including corporate jets, medical evacuation helicopters, and airplanes owned by individuals for business and personal use — are flown in the United States

WHEREAS, general aviation and community airports serve those aircraft and play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operations of our businesses and farms; and

WHEREAS, general aviation airports in Ohio support more than 17,500 jobs with a payroll of more than \$688 million; and

WHEREAS, fractional aircraft companies, where multiple owners share the costs of purchasing, leasing and operating the aircraft, directly employ more than 1,400 Ohio workers; and

WHEREAS, Ohio is home to 151 public-use airports, which serve about 18,000 pilots and more than 8,000 registered aircraft; and

WHEREAS, many communities in Ohio depend on general aviation and community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists, and visitors to our state; and

WHEREAS, the United States faces a shortage of aviation professionals, with an estimated need of 212,000 pilots in North America over the next 20 years, and general aviation serves as a pipeline for those seeking careers in aviation; and

WHEREAS, aviation colleges and university programs and flight school operating at local airports throughout the state, including Kent State University, Ohio University, Ohio State University, the University of Cincinnati-Clermont College, and Bowling Green State University, serve an important role in training the next generation of pilots and mechanics; and

WHEREAS, the general aviation industry actively encourages students to consider careers in aviation through scholarships, events, and informational resources; and

NOW, THEREFORE, We, Mike DeWine and Jon Husted, Governor and Lieutenant Governor of the State of Ohio, do hereby recognize December as
