Whereas, The state of South Dakota has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions, aviation organizations, public airports, and airport operators; and,

Whereas, The South Dakota Department of Transportation has 70 public-use airports across the state, serving 2,247 pilots and over 1,260 general aviation aircraft; and,

Whereas, General aviation contributes to the state's economy, medical care, transports goods to Native American reservations, supports forest fire fighting, and boosts economic development for small communities; and,

Whereas, From the 2010 State Aviation System Plan, aviation supports nearly \$800 million in business sales, including over \$250 million in personal income and over 7,000 jobs; and,

Whereas, General aviation is integral to the state's response to emergencies and natural disasters, as well as a key component of business at South Dakota's commercial airports; and,

Whereas, The nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and direct Congressional oversight is necessary to ensure stable funding of this system; and,

Whereas, The communities within South Dakota depend heavily on general aviation and community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourism, and visitors to our state:

Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim June 2015 as

in South Dakota.
