
## STATE of WISCONSIN

WHEREAS; in addition to managing aviation-related funds, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation fosters the love of flight within our state's youth by facilitating opportunities like the Aviation Careers Education program, which provides high school students with valuable work experience, mentoring, and first-hand knowledge about aviation careers; and

WHEREAS; the Wisconsin Department of Transportation also partners with the Wisconsin Airport Management Association to operate the Fly Wisconsin Airport Passport Program, which encourages recreational flight to our state's airports, increases safety knowledge, and further develops pilot skills for more than 1,200 pilots throughout the world; and

WHEREAS; from July 22 through July 28, the focus of the aeronautics world will be on Oshkosh, Wisconsin, where "The World's Greatest Aviation Celebration," also known as the Experimental Aircraft Association AirVenture, takes place and approximately 590,000 people and 10,000 aircrafts generate more than \$170 million in total sales and more than \$96.5 million in total income;
