Whereas, The Alliance for Aviation Across America is a membership coalition of over 6300 individuals, businesses, agricultural group, Fixed-Based Operators, small airports, elected officials, and charitable organizations that are helping to raise awareness about the value of general aviation and local airports; and

Whereas, General aviation and the Double Eagle JF Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Albuquerque; and

Whereas, According to the 2016 New Mexico Airport System Plan Update, on-airport output in New Mexico contributes over \$2.3 billion to the economy; and

Whereas, General aviation not only supports New Mexico's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, investments in sustainable fuels and technologies, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and
