

# PROCLAMATION

## General Aviation Appreciation Month 2019

WHEREAS, the City of Brookfield in the state of Missouri has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the North Central Missouri Regional Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Brookfield; and

WHEREAS, Missouri is home to 122 public-use airports, which serve 8,825 pilots and 3,985 active general aviation aircraft; and

WHEREAS, Missouri is home to 93 fixed-base operators, 58 repair stations, 123 heliports, 7 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,932 flight students and 1,604 flight instructors; and


WHEREAS, general aviation airports in Missouri support an economic impact of over \$857 million annually; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Missouri's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Lonnie Trentham, Mayor, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Brookfield and declare March as **General Aviation Appreciation Month** in the City of Brookfield.
