- WHEREAS, The City of Brookings has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions, aviation organizations, public airports and airport operators; and

- WHEREAS, General aviation is integral to the city's response to emergencies and natural disasters, as well as a key component of business at Rapid City Regional Airport; and
