WHEREAS, Colorado is home to 61 public-use airports, which serve 18,891 pilots and 6,731 registered aircraft; and

WHEREAS, Colorado is home to 70 fixed-base operators, 74 repair stations, 210 heliports, 11 FAA-approved pilot schools, 4,359 student pilots and 3,916 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation airports in Colorado contribute \$2.4 billion to the state's economy; and


