- WHEREAS, General Aviation and Community Airports play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operation of our businesses and farms; and
- WHEREAS, The state of New York has a significant interest in the continued vitality of General Aviation, Aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions and aviation organizations and community airports and airport operators; and
- WHEREAS, There are 90 public-use airports that are used by 17,449 pilots and 6,457 general aviation aircraft; and
- WHEREAS, According to New York Department of Transportation, the economic impact of general aviation airports is \$1.06 billion. The total economic impact of aviation totals over \$50 billion; and
- WHEREAS, General Aviation plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and
- WHEREAS, The nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important, public benefit and direct Congressional oversight is necessary to ensure stable funding of this system; and
- WHEREAS, New York is home to 72 charter flight companies, 129 repair stations, two fractional providers and 16 flight schools operating 85 aircrafts, which provide 235 jobs. In addition, there are 78 fixed-based operators in the state; and
- WHEREAS, Many communities in New York depend heavily on General Aviation and Community Airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists and visitors to our State.
