WHEREAS, general aviation and the Galesburg Municipal Airport have an immense economic impact on Illinois; and

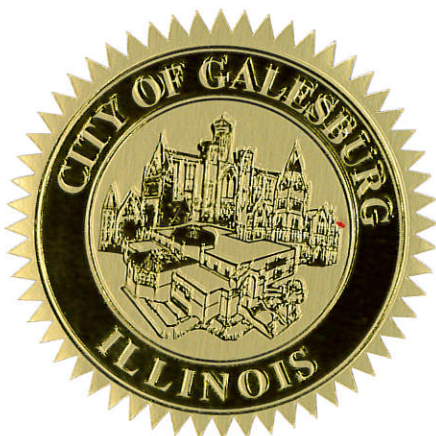
