around the state and over \$2 billion in economic impact attributable to the states

aviation industry.

**WHEREAS:** The nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important, public benefit, and

direct, Congressional oversight is necessary to ensure stable funding of this system.

**WHEREAS:** Numerous Aviation organizations and associations recognize and promote the

interests and importance of aviation in Oregon and throughout the world.

**WHEREAS:** Many communities in Oregon depend heavily on General Aviation and Community

Airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists and visitors to our State.
