GENERAL AVIATION PROCLAMATION - JULY 2015

WHEREAS: the City of Lafayette in the state of Indiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS: general aviation and local airports; including Purdue University Airport, have an immense economic impact on the City of Lafayette; and

WHEREAS, Indiana is home to 115 public-use airports, which serve 9,684 pilots and 3,675 active general aviation aircraft; and

WHEREAS, Indiana is home to 72 fixed-based operators, 58 repair stations, 650 heliports, 4 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,724 flight students and 1,655 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation in Indiana contributes \$5.9 billion to the state's economy annually; and

WHEREAS: general aviation not only supports Indiana's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, lawenforcement, firefighting, disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS: the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important, public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system;

THEREFORE, I, Tony Roswarski, Mayor of the City of Lafayette, Indiana, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Lafayette and declare July 2015 to be General Aviation Appreciation Month.
