this system.

WHEREAS: West Virginia airports provide access to businesses and tourists to isolated

areas, enabling businesses to remain part of the National Air Transportation

system and connected to the world's global marketplace.

WHEREAS: Many communities in West Virginia depend heavily on general aviation and

community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists, and

visitors to our State; and

THEREFORE: I, John Manchester, Mayor of Lewisburg do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the State of West Virginia and wish to declare October of 2014 to be
