

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Lewiston, Idaho, has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Lewiston-Nez Perce County Airport have an immense economic impact on Lewiston; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Idaho's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and health care services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system.

NOW THEREFORE, on behalf of the Lewiston City Council, I, Jim Kleeburg, Mayor of the City of Lewiston, do hereby proclaim July 2017 to be "*GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH*" and proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Lewiston.
