

MAYORAL PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of New Iberia in the State of Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports and,

WHEREAS, general aviation and local airports, including Acadiana Regional Airport, have an immense economic impact on the City of New Iberia and,

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 62 public-use airports, which serve 5,696 pilots and 3,264 active general aviation aircraft and,

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 61 fixed-based operators, 37 repair stations, 520 heliports, 7 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,215 flight students and 870 flight instructors and,

WHEREAS, general aviation in Louisiana contributes over \$966 million to the state's economy annually and supports more than 9,300 jobs and,

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Louisiana's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law-enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely and,

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important, public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system;

THEREFORE, I, Hilda Daigre Curry, Mayor of the City of New Iberia, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of New Iberia and declare March 2015 to be

General Aviation Appreciation Month.
