Proclamation**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Nevada's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting individuals to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Reno-Stead Airport have an immense impact on the City of Reno, as general aviation in Nevada contributes more than \$1.1 billion to the state's total economic output annually; and

WHEREAS, Nevada is home to 45 public-use airports, which serve 6,000 pilots and 4,600 registered general aviation aircraft; six FAA-approved pilot schools, 27 heliports, 1,225 flight students and 1,537 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit to Nevada and communities throughout the United States.


