- WHEREAS, the City of Ruston in the state of Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and
- WHEREAS, general aviation the Ruston Regional Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Ruston; and
- WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 63 public-use general aviation airports, which serve 5,475 pilots and 2,807 active general aviation aircraft; and
- WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 53 fixed-based operators, 33 repair stations, 228 heliports, 6 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,401 flight students and 913 flight instructors; and
- WHEREAS, general aviation airports in Louisiana \$966 million to the state's economy annually; and
- WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Louisiana's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destination quickly and safely; and
- WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a public system and serves communities of all size;
