Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport in the State of Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Shreveport Downtown Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Shreveport; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 62 public-use general aviation airports, which serve 5,579 pilots and 2,807 active general aviation aircraft; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 6 fixed-based operators, 33 repair stations, 228 heliports, 6 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,214 flight students and 918 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation airports in Louisiana contribute \$966 million to the state's economy annually; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Louisiana's economy, but it also improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Ollie S. Tyler, *Mayor* of the City of Shreveport, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Shreveport and declare the **month** of **March 2017** as

General Aviation Appreciation Month

In the City of Shreveport and call this observance to the attention of our citizens.
