## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the City of Shreveport in the State of Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

**WHEREAS**, general aviation and the Shreveport Downtown Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Shreveport; and

**WHEREAS**, Louisiana is home to 62 public-use airports, which serve 5,579 pilots and 2,807 active general aviation aircraft; and

**WHEREAS**, Louisiana is home to 60 fixed-based operators, 33 repair stations, 228 heliports, 6 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,214 flight students and 918 flight instructors; and

**WHEREAS**, general aviation airports in Louisiana contribute over \$966 million to the state's total economic impact; and

**WHEREAS**, general aviation not only supports Louisiana's economy, but it also improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

**WHEREAS**, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a public system and serves communities of all sizes;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Ollie S. Tyler, *Mayor* of the City of Shreveport, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Shreveport and declare the month of **November 2017**, as
