Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Shreveport in the state of Louisiana has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Shreveport Regional Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Shreveport; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 63 public-use airports, which serve 5,531 pilots and 3,914 registered aircraft; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana is home to 61 fixed-base operators, 33 repair stations, 260 heliports, 6 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,521 student pilots and 907 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation in Louisiana contributes more than \$966 million to the state's economy annually; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Louisiana's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a public system and serves communities of all sizes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Adrian Perkins, Mayor of the City of Shreveport, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Shreveport and declare October as

"GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH"

In the city of Shreveport, and urge everyone to celebrate this wonderful day.
