PROCLAMATION

General Aviation Appreciation Month

WHEREAS, Taylor in the state of Arizona has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations, and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Taylor Airport have a significant economic impact on the Town of Taylor; and

Whereas, the 2021 Arizona Aviation Economic Impact Study found that general aviation airports in the state support an annual economic impact of \$3.3 billion; in addition, state airports overall support more than 386,000 jobs, and a total payroll of over \$20.4 billion; and

Whereas, according to the FAA, the state has 78 general aviation airports. These airports serve more than 26,000 pilots and 7,800 registered aircraft; and

Whereas, according to the FAA, the state is home to 155 repair stations, 24 FAA-approved pilot schools, almost 8,000 student pilots, and almost 5,000 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Arizona's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, investments in sustainable fuels and technologies, and investments in innovative experimental technology like Vertical Takeoff and Landing vehicles, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the United States faces a shortage of aviation professionals, leaders should invest in this critical infrastructure to ensure future economic growth and our next generation of aviation professionals and pilots;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Shawn Palmer, Mayor of the Town of Taylor, do hereby proclaim August 2023 as GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH.
