

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the city of Terre Haute in the state of Indiana has a significant interest in the

continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational

institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS: general aviation and the Terre Haute Regional Airport have an immense economic

impact on the City of Terre Haute; and

WHEREAS: Indiana is home to 117 public-use airports, which serve 10,396 pilots and 4,914

active general aviation aircraft; and

WHEREAS: Indiana is home to 74 fixed-base operators, 54 repair stations, 118 public-and

private-use heliports, 12 FAA-approved pilot schools, 2,435 flight students and

1,728 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS: general aviation airports in Indiana contribute over \$5.8 billion to the state's total

annual economic impact; and

WHEREAS: general aviation not only supports Indiana's economy, it improves overall quality of

life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their

destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS: the United States faces a shortage of aviation professionals, with an estimated need

of 212,000 pilots in North America over the next 20 years, and general aviation

serves as a pipeline for those seeking careers in aviation; and

WHEREAS: the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and

Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a

public system and serves communities of all sizes.
