WHEREAS, the City of Wahpeton in the state of North Dakota has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Harry Stern Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Wahpeton; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota is home to 89 public-use airports, which serve approximately 3,600 pilots and about 2,000 registered aircraft; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota is home to 53 fixed-base operators, 12 repair stations, 17 heliports, 1 FAA-approved pilot schools, 856 student pilots and 496 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation airports in North Dakota support more than \$121 million in total economic output; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports North Dakota's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a public system and serves communities of all sizes;

**NOW THEREFORE, I,** Mayor Steve Dale, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Wahpeton, on behalf of the entire City Council and the Wahpeton community, do hereby proclaim March 2019 **GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH** in the City of Wahpeton and beyond.
