## "General Aviation Appreciation Month" PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, the City of Winnemucca in the State of Nevada has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

*WHEREAS*, general aviation and the Winnemucca Municipal Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Winnemucca; and

WHEREAS, Nevada is home to 45 public-use airports, which serve 6,000 pilots and 4,600 registered general aviation aircraft; and

*WHEREAS*, Nevada is home to 31 fixed-based operators, 33 repair stations, 27 heliports, 6 FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,225 flight students and 1,537 flight instructors; and

WHEREAS, general aviation in Nevada contributes more than \$101 billion to the state's total economic output annually; and

*WHEREAS*, general aviation not only supports Nevada's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law-enforcement, firefighting, disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

**WHEREAS**, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place of this system to ensure that it remains a public system and serves communities of all sizes;

**THEREFORE**, I, Richard Stone, Mayor of the City of Winnemucca, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Winnemucca and declare February 2019 to be General Aviation Appreciation Month in the City of Winnemucca.
