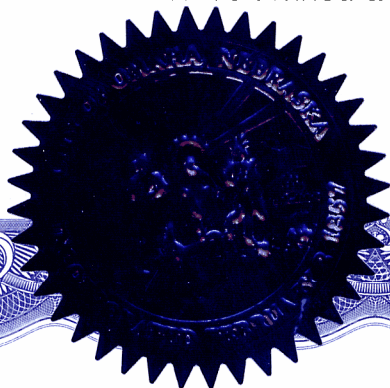
WHEREAS, The North Omaha Airport is home to Able1, the Omaha Police Department helicopter, which is an incredible asset to our local law enforcement, and
