City of Cincinnati

Be It Proclaimed:

Whereas, general aviation and community airports play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operation of our businesses and farms; and,

Whereas, the State of Ohio has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions, aviation organizations, and community airports and airport operators; and,

Whereas, according to the Ohio Department of Transportation, Office of Aviation, Ohio has a total of 150 public-use general aviation airports, and according to the FAA, these airports serve 15,586 pilots and 6,319 active general aviation aircraft; and,

Whereas, according to the Ohio Airports Economic Impact Study, general aviation airports in Ohio contribute more than \$1.8 billion to the state's economy; and,

Whereas, many communities in Ohio depend heavily on general aviation and community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists, and visitors to our state;

Now, Therefore, I, John Cranley,

Mayor of the City of Cincinnati do hereby proclaim December 2016

as

“General Aviation Appreciation Month”

in Cincinnati.
