## PROCLAMATION

*WHEREAS, the City of Grand Junction in the state of Colorado has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and*

*WHEREAS, general aviation and the Grand Junction Regional Airport have an immense economic impact on the City of Grand Junction; and*

*WHEREAS, Colorado is home to 61 public-use airports, which serve 17,583 pilots and 5,468 active general aviation aircraft; and*

*WHEREAS, Colorado is home to 68 fixed-base operators, 75 repair stations, 185 heliports, 9 FAA-approved pilot schools, 3,098 flight students and 3,668 flight instructors; and*

*WHEREAS, general aviation in Colorado contributes over \$2.4 billion to the state's economy; and*

*WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Colorado's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and*


