

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the City of Cody, in the state of Wyoming, has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aircraft manufacturing, aviation educational institutions, aviation organizations and community airports; and

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Yellowstone Regional Airport have an immense economic impact on Cody; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Wyoming's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and Congressional oversight should be in place to ensure stable funding of this system;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Matt Hall, Mayor of the City of Cody, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Cody and declare June 2017 as **GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH** in the City of Cody.
